



**Guadalupe County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club
2011 Scholarship Application**

The Guadalupe County **Texas A&M University** Mothers' Club will award scholarships of up to \$500 each to graduating high school students who will attend **Texas A&M University** at College Station as full time students or to currently enrolled, full-time, **Texas A&M University** (College Station) students. These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated excellent past performance in high school or at **Texas A&M University** and who exemplify the "spirit" of a true Aggie.

The following criteria have been established for the selection of recipients:

- 1) A graduating high school senior will attend **Texas A&M University** in the fall as a full-time student or a currently enrolled **Texas A&M University** full-time student in good standing (GPA of 2.0 or higher) and who has not received scholarship assistance from a **Texas A&M Mothers' Club**; and
- 2) Completes and submits the following by the due date:
 - a. Application form
 - b. Official high school or **TAMU** transcript
 - c. Resume
 - d. Essays as described in Section 2
 - e. Letter of Recommendation
 - f. Copy of letter of acceptance to A&M if high school or transfer student
- 3) Applicants shall have graduated from a Guadalupe County high school and/or their permanent address must be in Guadalupe County.
- 4) Current high school students **MUST** be accepted to **Texas A&M University** by March 31st to apply for this scholarship.
- 5) Applications should be typed or neatly handwritten.
- 6) Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Return the completed application to the Mothers' Club address listed below. The application must be postmarked on or before Friday, April 1, 2011. Please note: The deadline will not be extended.

If awarded a scholarship, students must present proof of fall enrollment at **Texas A&M University** on or before **September 23, 2011** in order to receive the scholarship. **There will be no exceptions.** Scholarships will be sent to the **TAMU** financial aid office after proof of enrollment has been received.

The recipients of the awards will be selected and notified on or before April 20th and the scholarship recipients will be recognized before the membership at the annual spring banquet on **April 25, 2011**.

4. Provide a well-developed, one-page essay answering one of the following questions:
 - a. *High School Applicants* – Why is attending **Texas A&M University** important to you?
 - b. *Currently enrolled TAMU students* – What have you gained as a student at **Texas A&M University**, and what do you hope to gain in the future?

SECTION 3:

Letter of Recommendation:

Recommendation should include some insight into the applicant's qualities and abilities that could include integrity, attitude/motivation, dependability, initiative, ability to get along with others, leadership and character. It must state how long the person has known the applicant, their relationship, the person's printed name, title, signature and date.

Applicants are reminded that Aggies do not lie, cheat or steal, nor do we tolerate among us those who do. Any falsification of information on this application is grounds for denial or termination of the scholarship.
